- She further mentioned that our school received the Extension of affiliation this year for the next five years.
- She also mentioned that the school has started CBSE-Senior Sec Section – Std XI Science stream from this academic year.

Ma'am, further mentioned about the Kalarang Online Competition conducted by City Pride School, Nigdi, in collaboration with PCMC Municipal Education Department. Our school came up with a bright idea of giving impetus to the latent talents of the children from municipal schools. Many children are not able to showcase their talents for want of either money or opportunity. It was felt that they too must get a platform to exhibit their talents and get appreciated for their efforts. Thus Kalarang – a gateway to colourful talents. About 105 students of STD I to IX from the municipal schools in the PCMC area participated in this online competition called KALARANG. The idea was met with equally enthusiastic participation of children in painting, singing, oration, essay writing and so on which incidentally also kept the judges busy as it was stupendous work to decide the first three winners. The competition took place during the Diwali holidays of November-December 2020.

The winners and their mentors were felicitated at the hands of honourable Shri Rajeshji Patil, Commissioner, PCMC and Mrs. Jyotsna Shinde, AO, Education Department, PCMC, in the IICMR hall of City Pride School premise, Nigdi on 19th July 2021.

Further Ma'am mentioned about the Foreign Youth Exchange program – NSLI- Y - our students are given an opportunity to participate in various International projects to give them a global exposure through our educational methodology. We host Foreign Youth Exchange program – NSLI- Y, National Security Language Initiative for youth under I-EARN India. Last year the students had online group discussions and also shared the videos on traditional dances of India. This year the school has hosted the Hindi Language Teaching program. Our school hindi teachers are teaching the American students Hindi language online. We also have our students as peer tutors. Parents are connected to share the Indian style of living and our culture.

Talking further, Madam mentioned about inclusion practices in school this year. This year we at CPS- Nigdi are really happy to share that we have connected ourselves with ZEP Rehabilitation Center, which deals with children with special needs and takes immense efforts to develop these children. CPS will be working on this project lifelong thus bringing a smile on the faces of these children and making them feel important and happy. These children visit the school twice a week.

We are also connected to an NGO in Ravet. The children in this NGO belong to the workers who work on construction sites and have no money, food to take care of their own children. CPS – Ravet school has taken the initiative to invite these children to their school. This MASTI KI PATHSHALA teaches these children in local language and conducts various activities.

Moving ahead with some more opportunities given to our students We have actively participated in **the PCMC COVID 19 Child Helpline**.

We are extremely happy about this initiative taken by PCMC. Its amazing to see the children creating awareness about COVID and developing confidence in the public. The entire team deserves lots of appreciation. We are sure in the coming years our students will be able to contribute in the progress of society and our Nation.

❖ **Special scheme of Assessment for STD 10**

- Ma'am briefed about the Special Scheme of Assessment for Board Examination Classes X for the Session 2021-22
- She said that last year due to the pandemic situation the Board exams were cancelled and the school followed all the norms of tabulation scheme and finally std X results are declared.
- For this academic the CBSE Board has given detailed instructions to be followed for std X and in the coming week STD X parents will be oriented with the same.
- Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni the Management Representative of the school appreciated the Principal, Vice Principal, Supervisor and all the teachers for the wonderful results of STD – X. She also stated that the school was able to successfully conduct the co- scholastic activities in the online sessions. She further also mentioned that the school has achieved another milestone by having 98% of attendance in the online sessions and appreciated the parents by stating that this was only possible as the parents having understood the importance of learning whether online or offline. She also appreciated the teacher's for their efforts which also one reason why the attendance is very good.

Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni the Management Representative of the school briefed about the concept of Advisory and E-PTA by stating that the E-PTA is constituted as per the norms of the government who represent a particular standard where we have one parent representative and one teacher representative from each standard. We also wanted parent representation from every class so that it helps to understand better the feelings of each class, as by this we can reach out to every parent effectively, and we at City Pride thought of starting an additional body i.e. the Advisory , by keeping intact the E-PTA body along with it. And in this way from

every standard we have 9 representatives. In this way we have 94 parents in our Advisory Body and 14 parent members as E-PTA committee, We have started this year our senior secondary division (CBSE- Science stream) and have one E-PTA representative from here too. Apart from this we also have representative from all our core committee members right from HOD's, coordinators, Vice-Principal to the Management Representative . In this way all the stake holders are part of this and we work in a democratic manner. This helps to be very close to our parents and we are very proud that our parents love the school and have always supported in our thick and thin times and have always supported us. And we also strongly believe that as a school it's our responsibility to be very transparent with all our parents by sharing our concerns, happiness & achievements of our children as both the parents and school have to work together for the children.

- She further stated that the school has already conducted class wise orientation in the month of June and July and now before 15th of August conducting the General Body Meeting. She further mentioned that the General Body meeting is being conducted as per the norms of the government.

❖ **Other points discussed:**

Ma'am initiated the discussion and encouraged parents and teachers to ask questions if they have any & also share their experiences. Following are the points of discussion:

- Mr Akshay Shah appreciated the school for carrying out various activities successfully without any hindrance since the past two years and have marked
- Aarna Malegonkar's parent appreciated the school for sending the Intra school competition trophies.
- One parent from STD 8th asked if the final exam of 8th standard going to be for 40 marks? Or 80 marks? Ma'am answered that very soon as detailed notice regarding the same will be sent once it's finalized.
- Mr Akshay Shah -All is already said but the way City pride family has come up in pandemic is really appreciated. CPS family has taken care of almost all the small things. Aarya kalyan's parent from 5th Love appreciated the school and applauded the school for the commendable community outreach programme done by the school.
- One parent asked can the school conduct a webinar for career in defense, specially opportunities' for girls? Ma'am answered that every year the carrier guidance programme is being conducted by the Counseling Department.

One parent said that his child enjoys pencil sketching a lot, it would be great if the school can also include pencil sketching in Art & Craft.... so that children can learn it technically ☺. Ma'am answered that will try to have a workshop for the same.

- Many parents suggested having speech competition during the intraschool. The speech competition has been added to the intraschool events.
- One parent said that last year intraschool got delayed as it was first time online...so children from joy section were bored very late till 7pm...as story telling started from 4pm. Ma'am told that this time the intraschool competitions will be held in the afternoon and not in the evening.
- One parent asked that for 11th std of CBSE only pcm stream is available. Why not pcb stream? Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni the Management Representative answered that the suggestion will be considered and definitely will think about it next year
- One parent asked how the care will be taken against Covid in school premises. Ma'am answered that definitely in City Pride school all the protocols are been taken care of and also mentioned about the Covid Warriors initiative taken by PCMC where children from City Pride school are a part of it.
- One parent asked will the reduction in syllabus continue like last year. Ma'am answered that while reducing the portion the school has never cancelled the portion which are based on concept clearing and has a link with the higher classes and only textual contents were deleted.
- One parent asked whether the Team meeting accounts were locked because few parents had not paid the first installment of the fee at the starting of the academic year 2021-2022?
Ma'am answered that this technical problem is not connected to the fee payment. Further she mentioned that the school had started on the date as previously mentioned to the parent's i.e 7th of June. Since there were certain parents who had not confirmed their ward's admission to the next class, their names were not ported to the next class. Two days before starting the school i.e on 7th of June the Computer team of City pride had worked day on this issue to resolve the problem and by Sunday evening had successfully ported all the names of the students. The school had started on Monday i.e 7th June 2021 with all the students list ported on the MS Team platform.
- One parent asked about the Council elections. Ma'am answered that definitely it will be conducted
- One Parent had a query regarding Sports Activities and the parent requested to send a detailed notice on the whatsapp group. Ma'am answered that the sports activities are happening in the morning as well as in the evening and definitely a detailed notice will be sent.
- One parent asked that will there be online school for students who do not wish to come to school since vaccination is not done and there is still COVID around? Ma'am answered that the school will wait for the directives given by the government and further stated that the school will follow the asynchronous method even if the regular school starts so that the learning will not stop
